

Jaguar Owners Adventure to the

Goodwood Revival

A ten-day tour of Southern England for Jaguar Enthusiasts

September 16-25, 2010



The Goodwood Revival is the world's most popular historic motor race meeting and the only event of its kind to be staged in the romantic time capsule of the Fifties and Sixties. As well as recreating the golden era of motor sport, the Revival offers exceptional wheel-to-wheel racing around a classic circuit, untouched by the modern world. It is a motor enthusiast's trifecta.

The Revival relives the glory days of Goodwood Motor Circuit, which ranked alongside Silverstone as Britain's leading racing venue throughout its active years between 1948 and 1966. During this time, it hosted contemporary racing of all kinds, including Formula One, the famous Goodwood Nine Hours race and the celebrated Tourist Trophy sports car race.

Now, for three days each September, the circuit stages a historic race meeting for the kind of cars and motorcycles that would have competed at Goodwood during 1948-1966. The circuit echoes to the spine-tingling bark of golden-age Grand Prix cars from the Fifties and Sixties, thundering sports and GT cars, as well as historic saloon cars and little-seen Formula Juniors. But the Revival is far more than a series of races for historic cars: it is a magical step back in time and a chance for visitors to revel in the romance and theatre of motor racing as it used to be. The lovingly restored circuit is unchanged from its heyday, and great lengths are taken to ensure that everything on the site is exactly as it was. Many visitors wear appropriate period clothing and no modern vehicles are allowed within the circuit perimeter throughout the weekend.

Thursday, September 16 Fly from your home city to London. Overnight on your flight. (Dinner on the plane)

Friday, September 17 We arrive London this morning where our deluxe motorcoach transports us to the **Brooklands Motor and Aviation Museum** where we'll enjoy a **specialist's tour**. There are lots of "firsts" that happened at Brooklands. In 1907 Brooklands Motor Course opened as the world's first purpose-built motor-racing circuit. Many of the original buildings from the early racing era are still standing and have been restored—the Edwardian Clubhouse, the original paddock workshops, tuning sheds and petrol pagodas of the 1920s and 30s. In 1909 the first public flying demonstration in Britain took place there in a Henry Farman biplane. Many other firsts ensued, in both motor racing and air records. Following our visit to Brooklands, we'll make our way to **Winchester, England**, where we'll check into our 1st class hotel for the next four nights. Overnight **Winchester Royal Hotel** or similar. (Breakfast on the plane; dinner)

Saturday, September 18 Today and tomorrow we attend all the festivities associated with the **Goodwood Revival**. Our deluxe motorcoach will take us to the estate of the Earl of March for the festival. Jaguar should be well-represented in the Earls Court Motor Show, along with a display of many of the fastest cars in the world. You may choose to really get into the spirit and dress in period costume. Our Goodwood ticket includes Grandstand best (chicane & woodcote) seats. Lunch and dinner will be on the Goodwood grounds on your own. Overnight Winchester Royal Hotel or similar.

Sunday, September 19 Today we attend Goodwood for a second day. If you've seen all you desire at Goodwood, we offer sightseeing and shopping in **Salisbury, Stonehenge & Bath**. Lunch and dinner will be on the Goodwood grounds on your own. Overnight **Winchester Royal Hotel** or similar.

Monday, September 20 Following breakfast this morning, we make our way to Portsmouth for an up-close visit to the **Portsmouth Historic Dockyard**. Here we'll see the Lord Nelson's *HMS Victory* and *HMS Warrior*. After lunch, we travel to Beaulieu for an in-depth visit to the **National Motor Museum**. This remarkable museum has everything from one of Campbell's famous Bluebird's to Bugatti's to F1 race cars. There are some 300 historic vehicles plus motoring memorabilia, the home of the Montague family, and Abbey Ruins on the grounds. The museum curator will lead our tour of this British treasure. Overnight **Winchester Royal Hotel** or similar. (English breakfast included)

Tuesday, September 21 We travel to **Oxford**, the "city of dreaming spires" for a tour of one of the colleges that make up Oxford University. Here we'll have free time for exploring after our walking tour of **Christ Church College**. This afternoon, we'll travel through the scenic **Cotswold's** to **Stratford-on-Avon**, home of William Shakespeare. Here we'll enjoy a guided tour as well as free time in this quaint town, surrounded by half-timbered buildings built along cobblestone streets. Overnight **Mercure Shakespeare Hotel** for the next four nights. (English breakfast and dinner included)

Wednesday, September 22 Our tour takes us from Stratford to **Malvern** and **Coventry** today. We'll begin with a private tour of the **Morgan Motor Company**. Then we'll make our way to **Castle Bromwich** for a tour of the Jaguar Plant. We'll enjoy a private tour of the Jaguar **Daimler Heritage Museum**. Overnight **Mercure Shakespeare Hotel**. (English breakfast and lunch included)

Thursday, September 23 Today we visit the famous **Donnington Park Grand Prix** with a specialist guide. You'll enjoy free time this afternoon in Stratford to follow your own interests. Overnight **Mercure Shakespeare Hotel**. (English breakfast included)

Friday, September 24 Following breakfast, we travel by deluxe motorcoach to Gaydon where we'll enjoy a curator led tour of **Gaydon Heritage Motor Centre**. This afternoon, we'll tour the **Aston-Martin Headquarters** before returning to Stratford-on-Avon for our farewell dinner. Overnight **Mercure Shakespeare Hotel**. (English breakfast and dinner included)

Saturday, September 25 Today we'll make our way back to London for our flights back to the U.S.A. If you choose our optional London extension, we'll make our way to our London hotel and begin exploring this wonderful city for the next three days. (English breakfast included)

London Optional Extension

Join fellow Jaguar owners on an extension to the lively city of London. We'll stay in a first class hotel and travel about the city independently using a tube/bus pass good for zones 1 and 2, seeing all the sights YOU want to see. Your tour director will be there to lead you to these sights, but admissions, lunch and dinner will be on your own. If you desire to explore on your own, your tube/bus pass will get you there! Extension package includes transfers to and from the airport.
